

How to Navigate Canvas

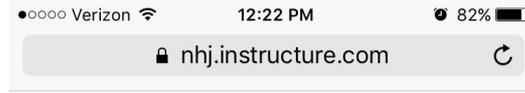


Once a Canvas account has been set up on a computer, the account can be accessed from any device.

The URL is: nhj.instructure.com
Or there is an ios app.

Login with the set username (email for non-student users) and password.

Note: The observer account must be set up on a computer. Please see the *How to Create a Parent Observer Account Tutorial* for directions.



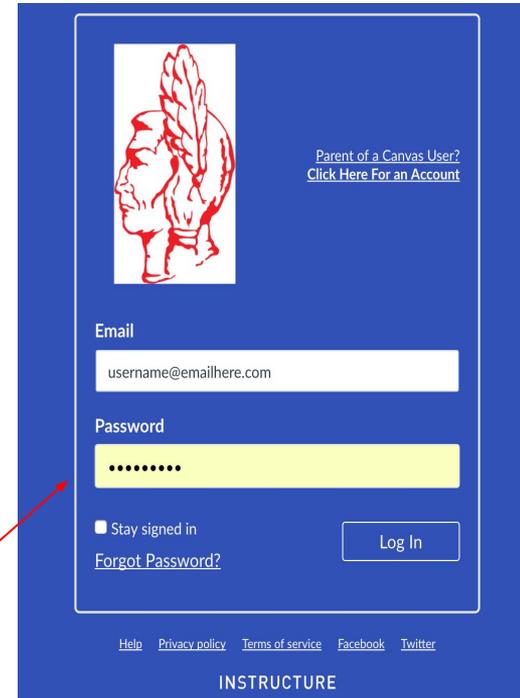
This is the login screen from a phone or tablet.

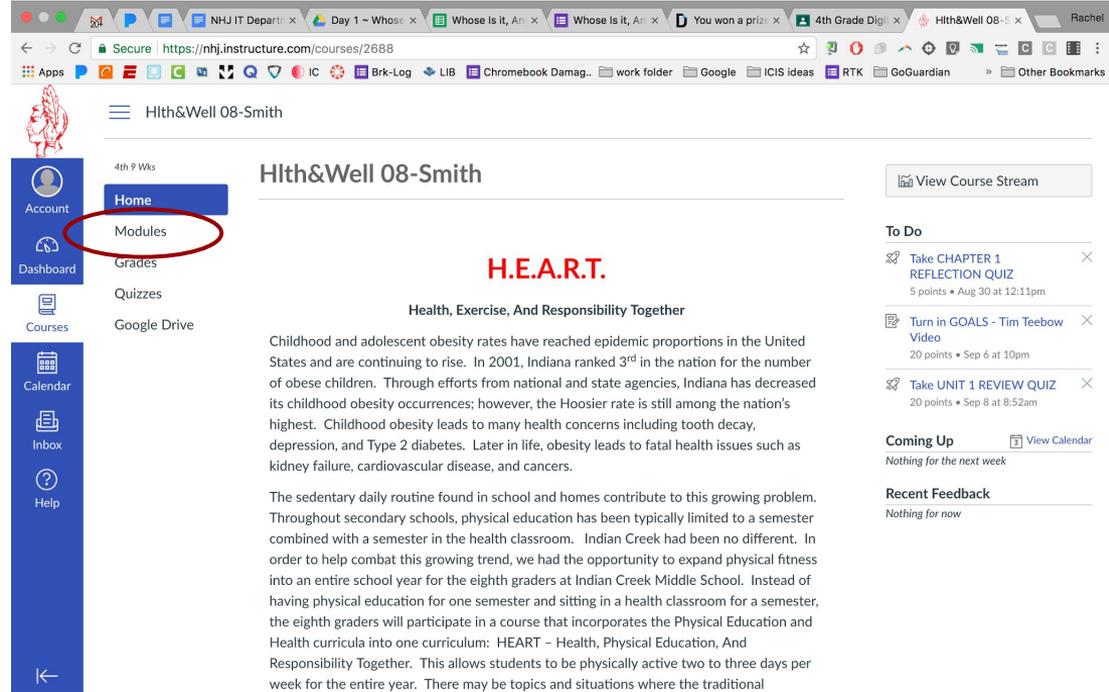

Click on the course tile name to open the course.

After clicking on a tile to open a class, the class's home page will be the first thing to display on the screen.

This will contain general information about the class.

To navigate to the daily material click on “Modules”, located on the left side menu.

Modules will contain many needed items.

Each teacher will have a “Weekly Agenda” Module. In this module, teachers can present what the weekly plan is in a variety of ways. But, in each way, it will list out the daily topics and if any assignments, quizzes, or tests will be occurring that day.

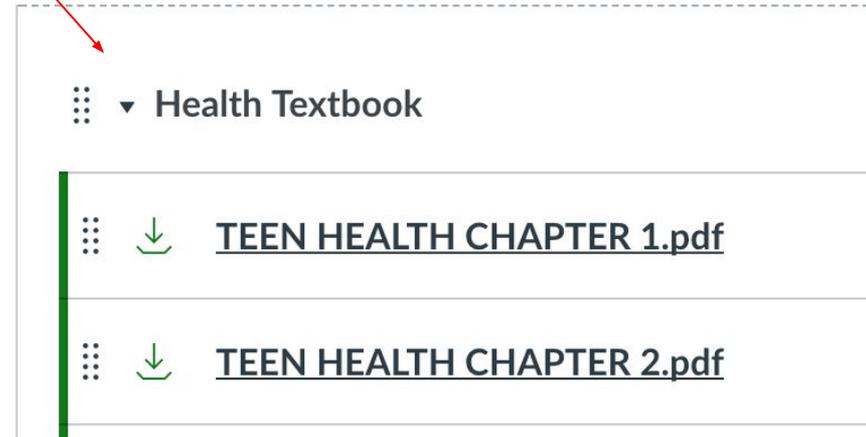
