PARENT TIPS

Allow children time for some unstructured play: When children play together, parents shouldn't plan all the fun. Let the kids decide what to do for a while. Then consider an organized activity, such as reading or coloring pictures. This provides a nice break, which can lead to more free play.

IS YOUR CHILD TOO SICK FOR SCHOOL?

The following information is guidelines regarding a child's return to school. Please keep your child at home if any of the following occurs:

1. Vomiting within the last 24 hours.
2. Diarrhea within the last 24 hours.
3. Temperature of 100 degrees or higher within the last 24 hours.
4. Any symptoms of acute illness such as persistent cough, runny nose with body aches. Your child should look and behave like him/herself for 24-48 hours before he/she is able to build resistance.
5. To protect the other children and school staff from communicable diseases that your child may transmit. Remember hand washing is the most effective means of preventing the spread of communicable diseases!
