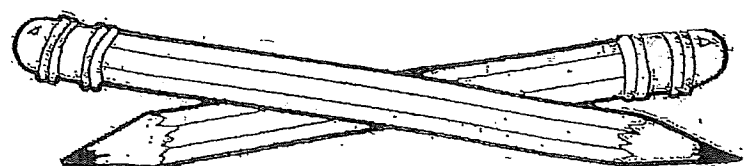
POP TABS

PARENT TIPS

Listening to your child read:

Offer encouragement. Pointing out what your child does well can help him do it again. ("Your voice sounded growly-just like a bear-when you read that line!") **Idea:** If he/she hesitates over too many words, let him/her pick an easier book.

CHARACTER COUNTS

The month of September the ICES students will be focusing on bullying. We will talk about being a bully, being the bystander (or the witness to the bullying) and then figure out together what all three groups can do to make ICES a more bully free environment and can lead to absences from school. There are things parents can do to help. If your child is being bullied: If your child is the bully: talk with your child, talk with the teacher privately, apply reasonable consequences for their age, encourage them to change and help them build skills. If your child is the bystander: tell them to refuse to join in, encourage them to not turn into a bully by fighting or name-calling themselves.
